Please use the guides below when planning your program to transfer to MCAD with an AFA or AA from Community College of Baltimore County. We have indicated the specific courses that meet our foundation curriculum requirements on page 1. Although MCAD does not participate in the Associate of Arts (AA) or Associate of Fine Arts (AFA), many of the courses in the AFA and AA also fulfill our requirements (see page 3). Our objective is to aid students toward their goal of earning a bachelor degree from MCAD and to provide a smooth transition that minimizes loss of credit and duplication of coursework.

CCBC AFA Art Electives: (21 credits): Complete a minimum of seven three-credit courses with at least one from General Education Electives. Highlighted courses below follow the recommended course sequencing for the AFA.

MCAD Studio Credit Requirements- The [CCBC AFA studio art electives](#) in the areas of Art, Design, and Interactive Media may transfer as studio electives to MCAD (p.1). A studio transfer portfolio and syllabus is required for transfer review to receive upper level studio requirement credit. MCAD has maximum allowable studio transfer credits; please contact your Admission Counselor for guidance.

MCAD Humanities and Sciences Requirements- MCAD's BFA degree requires completion of one 3-credit course in each of the following areas for a total of 15 credits: Science and Economic Systems, Histories Places and Philosophies, Liberal Arts Elective, Creative & Professional Writing. MCAD also requires a Liberal Arts Capstone Course which does not have a Community College of Denver equivalent for a total of 18 Humanities and Sciences credits in the BFA degree.
